Mt. Lebanon Commissioners Support Cuccia Bill

Mount Lebanon, Pa. -- The Mount Lebanon Commissioners on Monday passed a resolution in support of a bill to provide education to teens about dating violence.

The bill is called the Demi Brae Cuccia law, in honor of Demi Cuccia, who was killed on the day after her 16th birthday in 2007 by her ex-boyfriend.

Since then, a bill was introduced in Harrisburg to mandate teaching of dating violence as part of the high school curriculum statewide.

The bill passed the House, but it's in committee in the Senate.

One of the Mount Lebanon commissioners, Joe Deluliis, is the father of Sarah Deluliis, who was beaten with a hammer by an angry boyfriend.

Seven states have laws requiring school districts to teach about teen dating violence.
